Boat Basin News



The Sorrento Dock Owners Association, along with our HOA, has installed two benches (one pictured above) overlooking the boat basin. One bench specifically honors the decades of work, sweat and tears on the docks by Denny Korinek. They are a great way to watch the sunset and our manatees.

After 50+ years of slowly filling in, our boat basin is in need of dredging. Several slips are nearly awash at low tides. Therefore, the SDOA has signed a contract to have the low areas dredged. Work will begin at the end of May and is expected to end in July. Slip owners will be notified if and when their boats must be moved to accommodate dredging. SDOA members, the SDOA, and our HOA all pitched in to pay for this necessary improvement to our community.

Please remember that all Sorrento South waters are NO WAKE zones...boats tied up can be damaged by wake and, of course, we have endangered manatees feeding and sleeping in the basin. If you see a boat creating a wake, we ask that you either address it with the captain, or take a photograph of the name or hull number and let someone from the SDOA handle it.
